We'll most likely break into three different groups. And, we'll try and ensure each group has at least one experienced trail guide, and at least one vehicle with a winch.



Weather


The evenings will be in the 40 - 50 at that time of the year. (Coats / tall boots for potential mud. There are areas which can get quite muddy).
