ATTENDANCE / GROUPING

We have around 19 who've filled out the survey. Estimated final around ~25 vehicles.

We'll most likely break into three different groups. And, we'll try and ensure each group has at least one experienced trail guide, and at least one vehicle with a winch.

There was a thought of potentially dividing the three groups based on trail difficulty / vehicle capability (Gnarley / Off-road / Scenic group). If not, there are by-passes for most of the difficult obstacles.
